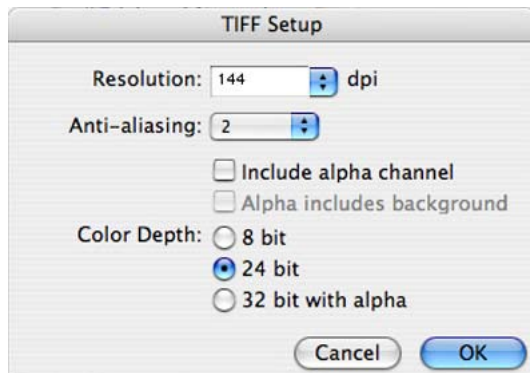
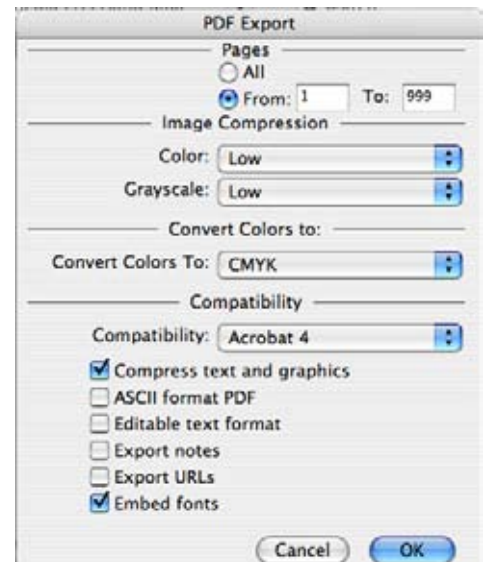


Exporting FreeHand files as a PDF, TIF or JPG

Exporting as a PDF

Go to the “File” menu and choose “Export...”. Where it says “Format:”, select “PDF” from the drop-down menu then click “setup”. Set Image Compression to “Low” for both colour and grayscale. Where it says “Convert colours to:”, select “CMYK”. Lastly, tick the boxes, “Compress text and graphics” and “Embed fonts”. Now click “Ok”. Choose a place to save your file and click “Export”.



Exporting as a TIF

Go to the “File” menu and choose “Export...”. Where it says “Format:”, select “TIFF” from the drop-down menu then click “setup”. Check that the resolution is set at 300Dpi and the colour depth is set to 8-bit. Now click “Ok”. Choose a place to save your file and click “Export”.

Exporting as a JPG

Go to the “File” menu and choose “Export...”. Where it says “Format:”, select “JPEG” from the drop-down menu then click “setup”. Check that the resolution is set at 300Dpi and the image quality set at 100%. Now click “Ok”. Choose a place to save your file and click “Export”.
