

Exporting Illustrator files as a PDF, TIF or JPG

Saving as a PDF

Go to the “File” menu and choose “Save As...”. Where it says “Format:”, select “Adobe PDF” from the drop-down menu. Choose a place to save your file and click “Save”. Another window should pop up. At the top where it says “Adobe PDF Presets” select “[High Quality Print]”. This will change all the settings to make a PDF ready for printing. Now click “Export”.

Exporting as a TIF

Go to the “File” menu and choose “Export...”. Where it says “Format:”, select “TIFF” from the drop-down menu. Choose a place to save your file and click “Save”. Another window should pop up. Set the colour mode to CMYK and the resolution to 300dpi. The other settings should be ok as they are. Now click “Ok”.



Exporting as a JPG

Go to the “File” menu and choose “Export...”. Where it says “Format:”, select “JPEG” from the drop-down menu. Choose a place to save your file and click “Save”. Another window should pop up. Set the Image Quality to “Maximum” and the resolution to 300dpi. Now click “Ok”.
